<p><b>Earliest date to REQUEST your VOTE-BY-MAIL (Absentee) ballot.</b></p> <p>To vote by mail, you must first be registered to vote. You will also need a form of voter identification, such as a government-issued driver's license or identification card.</p> <p><b>Track your ballot once you send it in or cast it.</b></p>	<p><b>Voter Registration Deadline!</b></p>	<p><b>EARLY VOTING BEGINS</b></p> <p>Georgia voters have three weeks before Election Day for early voting, including two Saturdays. Your county can also offer voting on Sunday. You can vote at any early-voting location in your county. So, find one that is convenient and has the shortest line. Look for the list of sites in your county and their hours.</p>	<p><b>Saturday Statewide Voting</b></p> <p>Saturday Voting in all counties for the November General Election Polling places are open on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. If you are in line by 7:00 p.m., you are allowed to cast your ballot.</p>	<p><b>LAST DAY TO REQUEST YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOTT</b></p> <p>Application must be received 11 days BEFORE Election Day                      Ballot must be returned by the time the polls close on 11/8.</p>	<p><b>EARLY VOTING ENDS</b></p> <p>Last day to vote early before Election Day.</p>	<p><b>ELECTION DAY! (7 am – 7 pm)</b></p> <p>Take your friends, water, headphones, or a book in the event the lines are long.</p> <p><b>Your Vote. Your Power</b></p>
